



TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE for the 2010-2011 Academic Year

Annual Registration

Returning Students \$450.00 per student
(Includes students entering Salem School from Salem Early Childhood)
After Feb. 26, 2010, returning students will pay \$600.00 per student

New Students \$950.00 per student

All Registration Payments are Non-refundable

Annual Tuition – Grades Kindergarten through Eighth

One Student	\$7000.00
Second and Subsequent Student (10% discount)	\$6300.00

Tuition is non-refundable and the annual Enrollment and Tuition Agreement is binding.

Please do not delay pre- registration due to the inability to make full payment. Contact the school office/Mrs. Weinberg to arrange a plan.

Tuition Payment Options

Annually by August 20, 2010
Bi-annually First Semester by August 20, 2010 and Second Semester by January 20, 2011
Ten monthly automatic drafts to SMART Tuition Management Services to be paid in full by May 20, 2011*

***A one-time administrative fee of \$75 per family will be collected in August at Final Registration from those choosing this option.**

Late tuition payments will be assessed late fees and/or consequences according to the Enrollment and Tuition Agreement.

The annual tuition and registration fees cover most costs except school uniforms and school lunches. Parker is the uniform provider. Some field trips and extra-curricular activities occurring after school, such as athletics in grades 5 through 8, will have an additional fee.

Tuition Reduction

A pre-determined amount is available for assisting families with tuition reductions. Qualification is based on need as determined by a third party evaluation through the submission of a confidential assessment form and the most recent IRS 1040. Families seeking tuition assistance must submit the necessary forms (confidential assessment application and IRS 1040) **online to Tuition Aid Analysis Service** by the required date. Families will then be notified by mail in late spring/early summer as to the amount of tuition reduction granted. The *Acceptance Letter must be signed and returned by June 30, 2010*. Should families need to discuss their tuition reduction further, they must call the school office and set up an appointment with the school commission. Late enrolling families seeking tuition reduction may apply but funds may be limited and subject to review and approval by the school commission.

Should a need arise in the area of tuition reduction or any other school-related expense during the school year, please contact the school office immediately for help in the matter.
